



2023 Spring Edition Class Descriptions

1. **OPEN BREED MODEL MARES**
2. **OPEN BREED MODEL STALLIONS & GELDINGS**

Model classes are horses shown in hand. Each horse should be as clean and groomed as possible for current weather. All horses will be in the arena at the same time, walked in the arena by hand and then stood up to show the best of their conformation for their breed. Horses will be judged on manners, conformation and then turn out/cleanliness/grooming, weather permitting.
3. **PERUVIAN PASO PERFORMANCE**

The Peruvian Paso Performance class horses will be judged at the Paso Llano while making one circle to the left, weaving through cones, then two circles to the left. The class will reverse and the same maneuvers will be called to the right.
4. **OPEN BREED PERFORMANCE/PATTERN RIDING CLASS**

The Open Breed Performance class horses will be judged at the jog/trot on the rail and will be asked to make one circle to the left, weave through cones, then two circles to the left and a halt. The class will reverse, and the same maneuvers will be called to the right. Watching the prior Peruvian Paso performance class is a great way to see how the class is run.
5. **OPEN BREED DRIVING – ALL DIVISIONS WELCOME**

Any breed of horse shown as a driving horse. Pleasure, fine harness, draft breeds, miniature horses etc. All horses will be asked to show two gaits such as a walk/animated walk and pleasure gait/ show gait – judge will call the class to accommodate the horses entered on a per class basis.
6. **TWH COUNTRY PLEASURE 2 GAIT, OPEN (COUNTS FOR TWHBEA POINT PROGRAM)**

A Tennessee Walking Horse class that is breed specific, meaning that all entries must be Tennessee Walking Horses. Horses will be asked to flat walk and running walk in both directions of the arena. This class will count for TWHBEA points as approved by TWHBEA.
7. **OPEN BREED ENGLISH PLEASURE WALK/TROT**

Any breed of horse may participate. Rider should be in English attire, the horse should be in English tack and the pair will be judged at the walk and trot.
8. **SADDLESEAT PARK – OPEN**

A class open to any breed of horse, such as American Saddlebred, Morgan, Arabian, that will be shown in a park horse manner, in saddleseat attire. Horse will be judged on action of movement and execution of gait.
9. **OPEN GAITED BREED COUNTRY PLEASURE WALK & FAVORITE GAIT (COUNTS FOR TWHBEA ALL DAY PLEASURE)**

A class open to any breed of gaited horse, Horses will be asked for their breed specific walk and breed specific second gait. Horses may be shown English or Western. This class will count for TWHBEA points as approved by TWHBEA.
10. **OPEN BREED ‘COME AS YOU ARE’ WALK/TROT, JOG OR GAIT – (SHOW TACK OR ATTIRE NOT REQUIRED)**

A class open to any breed of horse, any skill level of rider and show tack or show attire is not required, although Close toed shoes and pants are required.
11. **TWH 2 GAIT STALLIONS & GELDINGS OPEN**

A class specific to the Tennessee Walking horse, for Geldings or stallions only. Any level of rider may participate. Horses will be shown at the flat walk and running walk.
12. **SADDLESEAT WALK/TROT PLEASURE**

A class open to any breed of horse, such as American Saddlebred, Morgan, Arabian, that will be shown in a pleasure horse manner, in

saddleseat attire. Horse will be judged on manners and way of going. Horses can be asked to back in the lineup. In this class horses will be judged at the flat walk and the trot.

13. **OPEN BREED HUNTSEAT PLEASURE WALK/TROT**
Open to any breed of horse shown in Huntseat attire, with a Huntseat pleasure way of going, and that can perform a walk and a trot.

14. **OPEN GAITED BREED TRAIL PLEASURE (COUNTS FOR TWHBEA ALL DAY PLEASURE)**

Open to any gaited breed of horse. Both English and Western tack and attire is permitted. Horse will perform a trail walk, breed specific walk, breed specific second gait, and can be asked to halt. This class will count for TWHBEA points as approved by TWHBEA.

15. **RANCH ON THE RAIL – OPEN (WALK/JOG/TROT)**

A class open to any breed of horse capable of performing as a ranch horse. Horses will be asked to walk, jog, trot, extend the trot. Can be asked to halt or do other simple maneuvers at the judges discretion.

16. **TWH TRAIL PLEASURE 2 GAIT OPEN (COUNTS FOR TWHBEA POINT PROGRAM)**

A class specific to the Tennessee Walking Horse. Both English and Western tack and attire is permitted. Horse will perform a trail walk, flat walk, running walk, and can be asked to halt. This class will count for TWHBEA points as approved by TWHBEA.

17. **OPEN BREED NOVICE RIDER WALK/TROT OR JOG OR GAIT**

A class open to any breed of horse with a rider who has not won more than 3 blue ribbons.

18. **SADDLESEAT LIMIT RIDER - WALK/TROT**

A class open to any breed of horse, such as American Saddlebred, Morgan, Arabian, that will be shown in saddleseat attire. Horses will be asked to walk and trot. Rider should not have won more than 6 blue ribbons while showing.

19. **OPEN GAITED BREED EQUITATION 2 GAIT**

Open to any breed of gaited horse and any level of rider. This class is first judged on the equitation and seat of the rider, then on manners of the horse and then on execution of

gait. Can be shown in English or Western attire and tack.

20. **OPEN BREED WALK/TROT PLEASURE RIDER 17 YEAR OLD AND YOUNGER (ANY SEAT)**

Open to any breed of horse that can perform a walk and trot, ridden by any rider who is 17 years old and younger, in both Western, English or saddleseat tack and attire.

21. **TWH LIMIT HORSE OR RIDER 2 GAIT**

A class specific for Tennessee Walking Horses that will be shown at the flat walk and the running walk. Riders must not have won more than 5 blue ribbons while showing.

22. **WALK WALK CLASS – RIDERS WILL RIDE BOTH DIRECTIONS AT THE WALK, WILL CIRCLE OFF RAIL**

Any breed of horse and any age of rider may show. Riders will be asked to walk, animated walk (it is ok if your breed does not have an animated walk), circle off the rail and halt. Only the walk will be called in this class and is intended for new riders, confidence building and practice.

23. **RANCH ON THE RAIL- RIDER 17 YEAR OLD AND UNDER (WALK/TROT/LOPE)**

A class open to any breed of horse capable of performing as a ranch horse. Horses will be asked to walk, jog, trot, extend the trot and lope. Can be asked to halt or do other simple maneuvers at the judge's discretion. Rider must be 17 year old or younger.

24. **OPEN GAITED HORSE WESTERN PLEASURE 2 GAIT (COUNTS FOR TWHBEA ALL DAY PLEASURE)**

A class open to any breed of gaited horse, Horses will be asked for their breed specific walk and breed specific second gait. Horses will be shown in Western tack and attire. This class will count for TWHBEA points as approved by TWHBEA.

25. **SADDLESEAT OPEN 3 GAIT**

A class open to any breed of horse, such as American Saddlebred, Morgan, Arabian, that will be shown in a show horse manner, in saddleseat attire. Horse will be judged on action of movement, manners, presentation and execution of gait.

26. **TWH OPEN 3 GAIT**
A class specific for Tennessee Walking Horses that will be shown at the flat walk, the running walk and the canter. Open to any level of rider.
27. **OPEN BREED LEADLINE WALK/TROT**
Open to any breed of horse. Rider will have a handler that is leading their horse. Rider and handler will show the horse at the walk and trot, in hand. Please no riders over 12 years old unless cleared by show management.
28. **OPEN BREED LEAD LINE (RIDER 7 YEARS OLD AND YOUNGER)**
Open to any breed of horse. Rider will have a handler that is leading their horse. Rider and handler will show the horse at the walk.
29. **OPEN BREED PLEASURE DRIVING**
Open to any breed of horse that can perform a walk, a trot or jog and a breed specific pleasure gait while showing. Drivers can use a jog and/or a trot for both calls of the second gait for the class if needed.
30. **PERUVIAN PASO BREEDING LUXURY**
A Peruvian Paso specific class for stallions and mares only. Horses will be asked to walk, Paso Llano and the Sobreandando.
31. **RANCH ON THE RAIL- OPEN, ALL AGE (WALK/TROT/LOPE)**
A class open to any breed of horse capable of performing as a ranch horse. Horses will be asked to walk, jog, trot, extend the trot and lope. Can be asked to halt or do other simple maneuvers at the judge's discretion.
32. **RANCH HORSEMANSHIP (PATTERN CLASS)**
A class open to any breed of horse capable of performing as a ranch horse. Horses can be asked to walk, jog, trot, extend the trot and lope while following the pattern. Each rider shows their horse as one rider at a time in the arena. Pattern for the class will be available online and at the show office.
33. **RANCH ON THE RAIL WALK/TROT/LOPE CHAMPIONSHIP (BUCKE TO BE AWARDED)**
A class open to any breed of horse capable of performing as a ranch horse. Horses will be asked to walk, jog, trot, extend the trot and lope. Can be asked to halt or do other simple maneuvers at the judge's discretion. Rider may be of any age. Winner of the class will receive a championship belt buckle.
34. **SADDLESEAT WALK/TROT EQUITATION**
A class open to any breed of horse, such as American Saddlebred, Morgan, Arabian, that will be shown in saddleseat attire. Horses will be asked to walk and trot and will first be judged on the equitation of the rider, then the movement and manners of the horse.
35. **TWH AMATEUR RIDER 2 GAIT**
A class specific for Tennessee Walking Horses that will be shown at the flat walk and the running walk. Open to non pro/trainer riders of any age.
36. **WALK WALK EQUITATION CLASS – RIDERS WILL RIDE BOTH DIRECTIONS AT THE WALK, WILL CIRCLE OFF RAIL**
Any breed of horse and any age of rider may show. Riders will be asked to walk, animated walk (it is ok if your breed does not have an animated walk), circle off the rail and halt. Only the walk will be called in this class and is intended for new riders, confidence building and practice. Riders will be judged on their equitation and then the movement and manners of the horse.
37. **OPEN BREED WESTERN PLEASURE WALK/JOG**
A class open to any breed of horse that can perform a walk and a jog. Horse and rider must be in western tack and attire. Horses must be ridden one handed if in a curb or shank bit. Horses 5 years or under and in a snaffle may be ridden two handed.
38. **OPEN GAITED HORSE YOUTH 17 & UNDER TWO GAIT WALK & FAVORITE GAIT**
Open to any breed of gaited horse and for riders who are 17 years of age and under. Horses will be asked for their breed specific walk and breed specific second gait.
39. **ASB HUNTER COUNTRY PLEASURE**
An American Saddlebred specific class that is pointed for ASHBA. Rider must wear traditional huntseat attire, wearing tall boots, a hunt coat and a hunt cap style helmet while the horse must be shown in hunt seat tack. Horses will be

judged at the walk, trot and canter as well as on manners and way of movement.

40. **OPEN BREED EQUITATION ENGLISH OR WESTERN WALK/TROT, JOG OR GAIT**

Open to any breed of horse and any level of rider. This class is first judged on the equitation and seat of the rider, then on manners of the horse and then on execution of gait.

41. **TWH NOVICE HORSE OR RIDER 2 GAIT**

A class specific for Tennessee Walking Horses that will be shown at the flat walk and the running walk. Riders must not have won more than 3 blue ribbons while showing.

42. **ASB COUNTRY PLEASURE**

An American Saddlebred specific class that is pointed for ASHBA. Horses will be shown at the walk, trot and canter. Horses will also be asked to halt and back.

43. **GAITED HORSE 2 GAIT WALK AND FAVORITE GAIT**

Open to any breed of gaited horse. Horses will be asked for their breed specific walk and breed specific second gait.

44. **OPEN BREED NOVICE RIDER ENGLISH OR WESTERN WALK/TROT OR JOG, LOPE/CANTER**

A class open to any breed of horse with a rider who has not won more than 3 blue ribbons. Horses will walk, breed specific trot or jog, and breed specific lope/canter.

45. **TWH 2 GAIT MARES OPEN**

A class specific for Tennessee Walking Horses that will be shown at the flat walk and the running walk. Open to any level and age rider.

46. **RANCH CONFORMATION (IN HAND)**

Ranch Conformation classes are horses shown in hand. Each horse should be as clean and groomed as possible for current weather. All horses will be in the arena at the same time, walked in the arena by hand and then stood up to show the best of their conformation for their breed and skills of a ranch horse. Horses will be judged on manners, conformation and then turn out/cleanliness/grooming, weather permitting.

47. **MINIATURE HORSE - OPEN MODEL**

Model classes are horses shown in hand. Each horse should be as clean and groomed as possible for current weather. All horses will be in the arena at the same time, walked in the arena by hand and then stood up to show the best of their conformation for their breed. Horses will be judged on manners, conformation and then turn out/cleanliness/grooming, weather permitting.

48. **OPEN BREED SHOWMANSHIP (IN HAND – PATTERN CLASS)**

A class open to any breed of horse. Horses will be shown one at a time, in hand while following the pattern. Pattern for the class will be available online and at the show office.

49. **LEADLINE IN HAND OBSTACLE COURSE**

Any breed of horse, with a lead line rider, 12 years of age or younger. Horses will be led by hand and asked to navigate the trail challenge obstacle pattern that will be available online and in print at the show office.

50. **MINIATURE HORSE IN HAND TRAIL CHALLENGE**

Open to miniature horses, any age or level of handler. Horses will be led by hand and asked to navigate the trail challenge obstacle pattern that will be available online and in print at the show office.

51. **IN HAND TRAIL CHALLENGE**

Any breed of horse, any age or level of handler. Horses will be led by hand and asked to navigate the trail challenge obstacle pattern that will be available online and in print at the show office.

52. **NOVICE TRAIL (LEVEL 1) CHALLENGE OBSTACLE COURSE – WALK/TROT**

Open to any breed of horse, in any tack or attire. Rider needs to not have won more than 3 blue ribbons. Horses will need to walk and trot/jog or gait in the course.

53. **INTERMEDIATE TRAIL (LEVEL 2) CHALLENGE OBSTACLE COURSE – WALK/TROT OR GAIT**

Open to any breed of horse, in any tack or attire. Horses will need to walk and trot/jog or gait in the course. Level 2 is intended for an intermediate type rider and/or horse. Level 2 courses are more detailed than level 1 courses.

Level 2 horses are NOT eligible for novice classes, but are eligible for level 3/open classes. Level 2 *horses* must not have won more than 3 championships nor a level 2 or 3 high point within our association and you must not have won a championship, best of show or level two or higher high point with any other association.

54. **YOUTH 17 AND UNDER TRAIL CHALLENGE – WALK/TROT OR GAIT**

Open to any breed of horse, in any tack or attire. Rider needs to be 17 years of age or under. Horses will need to walk and trot/jog or gait in the course.

55. **OPEN TRAIL (LEVEL 3) TRAIL CHALLENGE – WALK/TROT/JOG OR GAIT**

Open to any breed of horse, in any tack or attire. Horses will need to walk and trot/jog or gait in the course. Level 3 is currently our most advanced and most technical course level. Any horse and rider pair may attempt any open or level 3 course.

56. **OPEN TRAIL (LEVEL 3) CHALLENGE OPSTACLE COURSE – WALK/TROT OR GAIT/CANTER OR LOPE**

Open to any breed of horse, in any tack or attire. Horses will need to walk and trot/jog or gait and lop/canter in the course. Level 3 is currently our most advanced and most technical course level. Any horse and rider pair may attempt any open or level 3 course.

57. **INTERMEDIATE TRAIL (LEVEL 2) CHAMPIONSHIP – WALK/TROT/JOG OR GAIT/LOPE**

Open to any breed of horse, in any tack or attire. Horses will need to walk and trot/jog or gait and lop/canter in the course. Level 2 horses are NOT eligible for novice classes, but are eligible for level 3/open classes. Level 2 *horses* must not have won more than 3 championships nor a level 2 or 3 high point within our association and you must not have won a championship, best of show or level two or higher high point with any other association. A buckle will be awarded to the winner.

58. **YOUTH 17 AND UNDER CHAMPIONSHIP – WALK/TROT/JOG OR GAIT/LOPE**

Open to any breed of horse, in any tack or attire. Rider needs to be 17 years of age or under. Horses will need to walk and trot/jog or gait and lop/canter in the course. A buckle will be awarded to the winner.

59. **OPEN TRAIL CHAMPIONSHIP – WALK/TROT/JOG OR GAIT/LOPE**

Open to any breed of horse, in any tack or attire. Horses will need to walk and trot/jog or gait and lop/canter in the course. Level 3 is currently our most advanced and most technical course level. Any horse and rider pair may attempt any open or level 3 course. A buckle will be awarded to the winner.

60. **OPEN BREED OPEN DRIVING**

Any breed of horse shown as a driving horse. Pleasure, fine harness, draft breeds, miniature horses etc. All horses will be asked to show two gaits such as a walk/animated walk and pleasure gait/ show gait – judge will call the class to accommodate the horses entered on a per class basis

61. **PERUVIAN PASO EQUITATION**

A Peruvian Paso specific class. Horses will be asked to walk, Paso Llano and the Sobreandando. Rider will be judged on equitation first, then manners and way of moving of the horse.

62. **OPEN GAITED BREED ENGLISH PLEASURE 2 GAIT OPEN (COUNTS FOR TWHBEA ALL DAY PLEASURE)**

A class open to any breed of gaited horse, Horses will be asked for their breed specific walk and breed specific second gait. Horses may be shown in English tack and attire. This class will count for TWHBEA points as approved by TWHBEA.

63. **OPEN BREED ENGLISH PLEASURE WALK/TROT**

Open to any breed of horse that can perform a walk and trot, in any English or saddleseat tack and attire.

64. **SADDLESEAT LIMIT RIDER - WALK/TROT/CANTER**
A class open to any breed of horse, such as American Saddlebred, Morgan, Arabian, that will be shown in saddleseat attire. Horses will be asked to walk, trot and canter. Rider should not have won more than 6 blue ribbons while showing.
65. **TWH OPEN 2 GAIT**
A class specific for Tennessee Walking Horses that will be shown at the flat walk and the running walk. Open to any level and age rider.
66. **OPEN HUNTSEAT PLEASURE WALK/TROT**
Rider must wear traditional huntseat attire, wearing tall boots, a hunt coat and a hunt cap style helmet while the horse must be shown in hunt seat tack. Horses will be judged at the walk and trot as well as on manners and way of movement.
67. **OPEN BREED JACK BENNY MAE WEST, RIDER 39 YEARS OLD & OLDER**
Open to any breed of horse. Rider must be aged 39 years old and older. Western, English or Saddleseat attire may be worn. Horses will be shown at the walk and their breed specific second gait such as a jog, trot or gait.
68. **OPEN GAITED BREED BAREFOOT – 2 GAIT**
Open to any breed of gaited horse. Horses will be asked for their breed specific walk and breed specific second gait. Horses must be barefoot and not have shoes on any foot.
69. **OPEN BREED WALK/TROT OR GAIT/CANTER PLEASURE RIDER 17 YEAR OLD AND UNDER (ANY SEAT)**
Open to any breed of horse that can perform a walk, trot and lope/or canter, ridden by any rider who is 17 years old and younger, in both Western, English or saddleseat tack and attire.
70. **SADDLESEAT EQUITATION**
A class open to any breed of horse, such as American Saddlebred, Morgan, Arabian, that will be shown in saddleseat attire. Horses will be asked to walk, trot and canter and will first be judged on the equitation of the rider, then the movement and manners of the horse.
71. **OPEN BREED EQUITATION WALK/TROT/CANTER**
A class open to any breed of horse. Horses will be asked to walk, trot and canter and will first be judged on the equitation of the rider, then the movement and manners of the horse. Horses may be shown in English, Western or Saddleseat tack and attire.
72. **OPEN GAITED HORSE 3 GAIT PLEASURE (COUNTS FOR TWHBEA ALL DAY PLEASURE)**
A class open to any breed of gaited horse, Horses will be asked for their breed specific walk and breed specific second gait as well as a canter. Horses may be shown in English or Western tack and attire. This class will count for TWHBEA points as approved by TWHBEA.
73. **SADDLESEAT 5 GAITED PLEASURE**
A class open to any breed of horse, such as American Saddlebred, Morgan, Arabian, that will be shown in saddleseat attire. Horses will be asked to walk, trot, canter, slow gait and rack.
74. **OPEN BREED HORSES OF COLOR**
Open to any breed of horse, ridden in English or Western attire. Class is limited to horses that are paint, spotted, palomino, grey, chocolate, white, buckskin etc – please no chestnut, black or bay color horses.
75. **OPEN HUNTSEAT PLEASURE WALK/TROT/CANTER**
Rider must wear traditional huntseat attire, wearing tall boots, a hunt coat and a hunt cap style helmet while the horse must be shown in hunt seat tack. Horses will be judged at the walk, trot and canter as well as on manners and way of movement.
76. **SADDLESEAT COUNTRY PLEASURE**
A class open to any breed of horse, such as American Saddlebred, Morgan, Arabian, that will be shown in saddleseat attire. Horses will be shown at the walk, trot and canter. Horses will also be asked to halt and back.
77. **TWH LADIES TO RIDE 2 GAIT**
This class is specific for Tennessee Walking Horses that will be shown at the flat walk and the running walk. Open to any level and age rider, however the rider must be female.

78. **OPEN BREED WESTERN PLEASURE WALK/JOG/LOPE**
A class open to any breed of horse that can perform a walk, jog and lope. Horse and rider must be in western tack and attire. Horses must be ridden one handed if in a curb or shank bit. Horses 5 years or under and in a snaffle may be ridden two handed.
79. **ASB HUNTER COUNTRY PLEASURE CHAMPIONSHIP STAKE**
An American Saddlebred specific class that is pointed for ASHBA. Rider must wear traditional huntseat attire, wearing tall boots, a hunt coat and a hunt cap style helmet while the horse must be shown in hunt seat tack. Horses will be judged at the walk, trot and canter as well as on manners and way of movement. A buckle will be awarded to the winner of this class.
80. **OPEN WESTERN PLEASURE CHAMPIONSHIP – WALK/JOG/LOPE**
A class open to any breed of horse that can perform a walk, jog and lope. Horse and rider must be in western tack and attire. Horses must be ridden one handed if in a curb or shank bit. Horses 5 years or under and in a snaffle may be ridden two handed. A buckle will be awarded to the winner of this class.
81. **OPEN BREED DRIVING CHAMPIONSHIP – ALL DRIVING DIVISIONS WELCOME**
Any breed of horse shown as a driving horse. Pleasure, fine harness, draft breeds, miniature horses etc. All horses will be asked to show two gaits such as a walk/animated walk and pleasure gait/ show gait – judge will call the class to accommodate the horses entered on a per class basis. A buckle will be awarded to the winner of this class.
82. **TWH 2 GAIT CHAMPIONSHIP**
A class specific for Tennessee Walking Horses that will be shown at the flat walk and the running walk. Open to any level and age rider. A buckle will be awarded to the winner of this class.
83. **OPEN BREED WESTERN CHAMPIONSHIP – WALK/JOG OR TROT OR GAIT (PLEASE NO TRAINERS/PRO RIDERS)**
A class open to any breed of horse that can perform a walk and jog/trot or gait. Horse and rider must be in western tack and attire. A buckle will be awarded to the winner of this class.
84. **SADDLESEAT WALK/TROT CHAMPIONSHIP (PLEASE NO TRAINERS/PRO RIDERS ENTERED)**
A class open to any breed of horse, such as American Saddlebred, Morgan, Arabian, that will be shown in saddleseat attire. Horses will be asked to walk and trot. A buckle will be awarded to the winner of this class.
85. **OPEN GAITED BREED CHAMPIONSHIP TWO GAIT – WALK & FAVORITE GAIT**
Open to any breed of gaited horse. Horses will be asked for their breed specific walk and breed specific second gait. English or Western tack and attire. A buckle will be awarded to the winner of this class.
86. **OPEN BREED YOUTH 17 & UNDER PLEASURE CHAMPIONSHIP – WALK/JOG OR TROT**
Open to any breed of horse that can perform a walk and trot and will be asked to halt. Must be ridden by a rider who is 17 years old and younger, in either Western, English or saddleseat tack and attire. A buckle will be awarded to the winner of the class.
87. **ASB COUNTRY PLEASURE CHAMPIONSHIP STAKE**
An American Saddlebred specific class that is pointed for ASHBA. Horses will be shown at the walk, trot and canter. Horses will also be asked to halt and back. A buckle will be awarded to the winner of this class.
88. **OPEN BREED ENGLISH CHAMPIONSHIP – WALK/TROT JOG OR GAIT (PLEASE NO TRAINERS/PRO RIDERS)**
A class open to any breed of horse that can perform a walk and jog/trot or gait. Horse and rider must be in English tack and attire. A buckle will be awarded to the winner of this class.

89. **SADDLESEAT OPEN PLEASURE CHAMPIONSHIP**
A class open to any breed of horse, such as American Saddlebred, Morgan, Arabian, that will be shown in saddleseat attire. Horses will be asked to walk, trot and canter. Horses will be judged on way of movement and manners. Horses may be asked to halt and back. A buckle will be awarded to the winner of this class.
90. **OPEN GAITED HORSE CHAMPIONSHIP 3 GAIT**
A class open to any breed of gaited horse, Horses will be asked for their breed specific walk and breed specific second gait as well as a canter. Horses may be shown in English or Western tack and attire. A buckle will be awarded to the winner of this class.
91. **OPEN ENGLISH CHAMPIONSHIP – WALK/ TROT OR GAIT/CANTER**
A class open to any breed of horse that can perform a walk and jog/trot or gait and canter. Horse and rider must be in English tack and attire. A buckle will be awarded to the winner of this class.
92. **SADDLESEAT JACKPOT OPEN CHAMPIONSHIP**
A class open to any breed of horse, such as American Saddlebred, Morgan, Arabian, that will be shown in saddleseat attire. Horses will be asked to walk, trot and canter. Horses will be judged on action, way of movement, grace and manners. A buckle will be awarded to the winner of this class.

Things to Remember:

Horse and/or riders may cross enter divisions and classes unless noted in the class description.

We encourage everyone to try something new – not sure if it is the right class to try? Don't hesitate to reach out to show management!

We promote good sportsmanship – be kind!

Championship classes require **TWO or more horses entered to run – one horse Championship classes will NOT be permitted.**
